Important information about TransGrid's Western Sydney Supply Project

TransGrid is proposing a \$569 million investment to secure Sydney's power supply for the future. This project is just one part of a five year, \$2.4 billion plan by TransGrid to upgrade the electricity transmission network across New South Wales. The Western Sydney Supply Project includes an upgrade of the transmission line near your property.

What are we doing?

TransGrid proposes to build a new substation at Hyland Road, Greystanes and upgrade the transmission line between the new substation and our existing substation in Horsley Park. More information on our plans can be found in the enclosed community update.

What does this mean to residents and businesses?

TransGrid proposes to change the operating voltage of the existing steel tower transmission line from 132,000 volts to 330,000 volts. The line was built to operate at 330,000 volts but has been operating at 132,000 volts for many years. TransGrid currently has an easement for the transmission line. Easements ensure the safety of transmission lines and the safety of landowners and others when they operate plant and equipment in the vicinity. Although there will be no change to the location to the existing transmission line, TransGrid will need to liaise with owners and occupiers regarding use of the land within the existing easement.
