### **Important information about TransGrid's Western Sydney Supply Project**

TransGrid is proposing a \$569 million investment to secure Sydney's power supply for the future. This project is just one part of a five year, \$2.4 billion plan by TransGrid to upgrade the electricity transmission network across New South Wales. The Western Sydney Supply Project includes a new underground transmission cable near your property.

#### **What are we doing?**

TransGrid proposes to build two new substations, one at Greystanes and the other at Potts Hill, and build an underground cable to connect them. More information on our plans can be found in the enclosed community update.

#### **What does this mean to residents and businesses?**

Over the next few months, you will see TransGrid's contractors undertaking technical investigations along the T-way, in the Sydney Water easement and at the substation sites. These investigations will help us determine and manage any potential environmental impacts this proposal may have.
