

Work Notification

Oversize truck movement through Goulburn – Thursday, 7 May 2026

Lagoon Street, Upper Sterne Street, Reynolds Street & Union Street

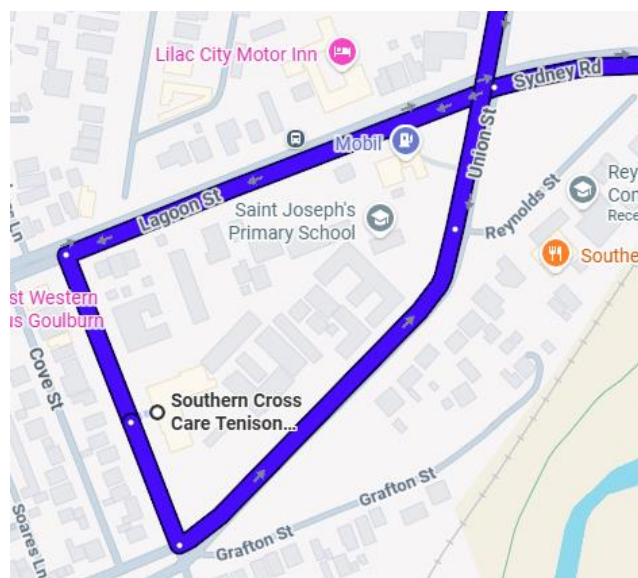
As part of the HumeLink East project, an oversize truck and trailer measuring 66 metres long and 4.5 metres wide will be travelling from Port Kembla to Bannaby via Goulburn, on Thursday, 7 May 2026.

The truck and trailer will be escorted by NSW Police, due to its length. It will be carrying a substation reactor weighing 134 tonnes, which will be installed at Transgrid's Bannaby substation.

It is expected to travel through Goulburn between **9.30am and 11am on Thursday, 7 May 2026.**

The route of the truck and trailer in Goulburn will be:

- Sydney Road
- onto Lagoon Street
- left onto Upper Sterne Street
- left onto Reynolds Street
- onto Union Street
- before heading out of Goulburn on Taralga Road.



How this affects you

Due to the length of the truck and trailer, a wide left turn from Lagoon Street into Upper Sterne Street and then another wide left turn into Reynolds Street will be required.

To assist the first left turn, we request that the following on-street parking areas at the corner of Lagoon Street and Upper Sterne Street be kept free of vehicles on the morning of 7 May 2026:

- 91 and 93 Lagoon Street
- Aligned Chiro on Upper Sterne Street
