Temporary road closures - Adjungbilly

HumeLink is one of NSW largest energy infrastructure projects, with about 365 kilometres of new 500kV transmission line which will connect Wagga Wagga, Bannaby and Maragle. The eastern portion between the existing Bannaby substation and Wondalga is being delivered by Acciona Construction Australia Pty Ltd and Genus Infrastructure (NSW) Pty Ltd in a joint venture as AGJV HumeLink East.

Temporary road closure near Adjungbilly

As part of construction of HumeLink East and stringing of new conductor cables, we will need to temporarily close a section of Gobarralong-Adjungbilly Road for short intervals **from June 15, 2026, for a period of three weeks**. The road will be closed for 5-10 minutes at a time and motorists may experience minor delays.

Where we are working

The road closure will be happening in the vicinity of **1241-1687 Gobarralong-Adjungbilly Road, Adjungbilly**. The indicative area is marked on the map below.



Traffic Impacts

The temporary traffic holds are permitted under the approved Cootamundra-Gundagai Regional Council permit conditions. HumeLink East will work to minimise disruption and keep delays to a minimum.

- Traffic will be held for short periods of 5–10 minutes at a time
- There will be up to six closures per day over the three-week period
- All closures will occur outside school zone hours.

Alternate routes

Stoppages will be kept as brief as possible as there are no practical alternate routes around the closure site. Detour options were considered but these would have added over one hour to trips.

How often will the road be closed

Closures of this section of road will begin from June 15, 2026, and go through until July 6, 2026. Traffic holds are expected to occur **approximately once per hour between 9:30am and 2:30pm.**

Please note that these times are indicative only and may vary depending on construction activities.

Signage

Electronic signage will be installed on Gobarralong-Adjungbilly Road advising motorists of the temporary traffic holds and expected delays in the area.
