

## Project update for Sydenham Road, Marrickville

Transgrid is installing a new underground electricity cable from Potts Hill to Alexandria. The Powering Sydney's Future project will help ensure a safe, reliable and affordable energy supply for Sydney's CBD and surrounding areas. As you will probably be aware, Transgrid has completed a number of work activities on Sydenham Road, Marrickville. We thank you for your patience during our work in your area so far. The next and final stage of work involves permanent restoration on Sydenham Road.

Works on Sydenham Road will start from **Thursday, 24 March 2022** and will take approximately **10** nights to complete. To minimise impact to residents in the area, the work will be completed over approximately five weeks with no more than two consecutive nights per week. If the weather forecast is poor, work will be rescheduled to the next available night.

### Work activities

- > Installing temporary fencing and safety barriers.
- > Delivering plant and equipment to site.
- > Saw cutting & hammering.
- > Milling the road surface.
- > Laying asphalt / concrete on the road.
- > Line marking.

### How will the work affect you?

**Two-way traffic on Sydenham Road will be maintained under stop/slow arrangements.**

**At times Centennial Street and Neville Street will be closed.**

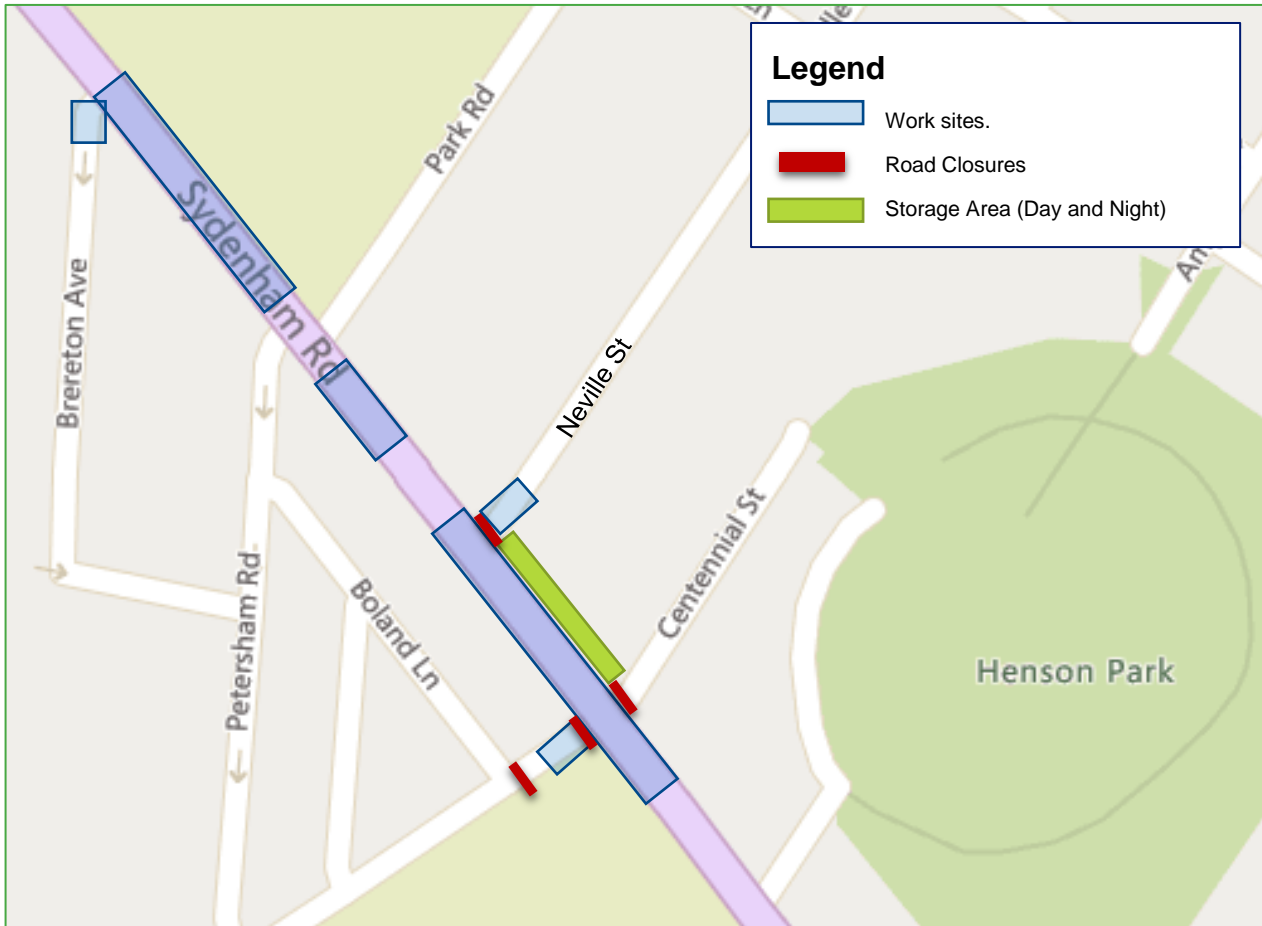
Access for residents will be maintained. Road users may experience short delays to access local properties.

The work will be loud at times, but we will make every effort to keep noise to a minimum.

Some construction materials will be temporarily stored on the roadway on Sydenham Rd. There may be temporary closures of pedestrian crossings but we will provide an alternative route.

Traffic control will be in place for the safety of pedestrians, workers and road users.
