Traffic disruption – Black Range Road, Woolgarlo

HumeLink is one of NSW's largest energy infrastructure projects, with about 365 kilometres of new 500kV transmission line which will connect Wagga Wagga, Bannaby and Maragle. The eastern portion between the existing Bannaby substation and Wondalga is being delivered by Acciona Construction Australia Pty Ltd and Genus Infrastructure (NSW) Pty Ltd in a joint venture as AGJV HumeLink East.

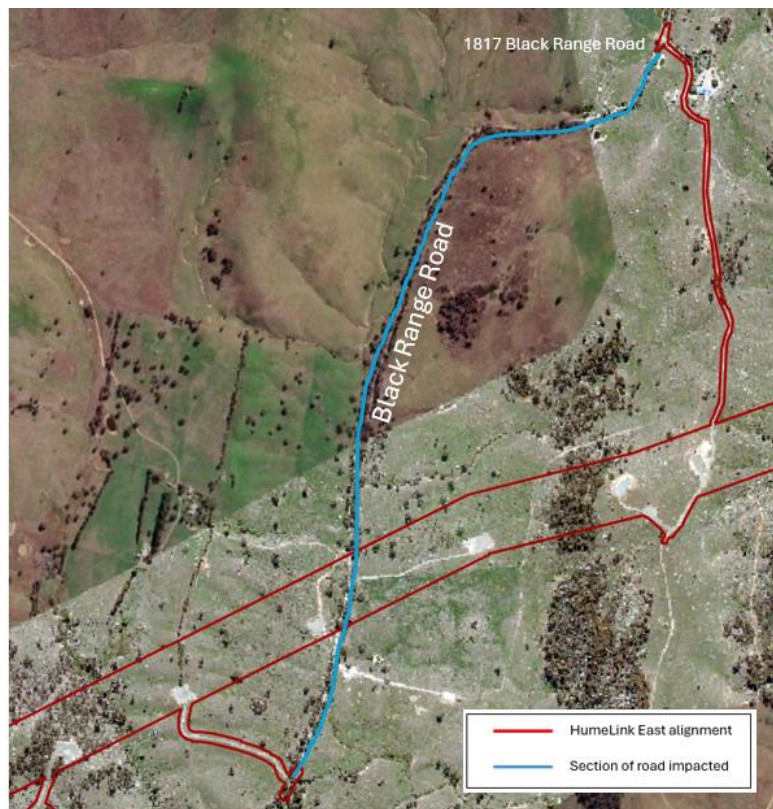
Traffic disruption Black Range Road near Woolgarlo

As part of construction of HumeLink East, we will be moving heavy machinery between tower pad construction sites near Woolgarlo. To do this there will be some traffic disruptions on the southern section of **Black Range Road** between **10am and 2:30pm** on the following dates: (may change due to weather)

- Tuesday 21 July
- Thursday 23rd July
- Thursday 29th July
- Thursday 13th August

Where we are working

Traffic disruptions will be along a 3-kilometre section of road to the south of **1817 Black Range Road, Woolgarlo**.

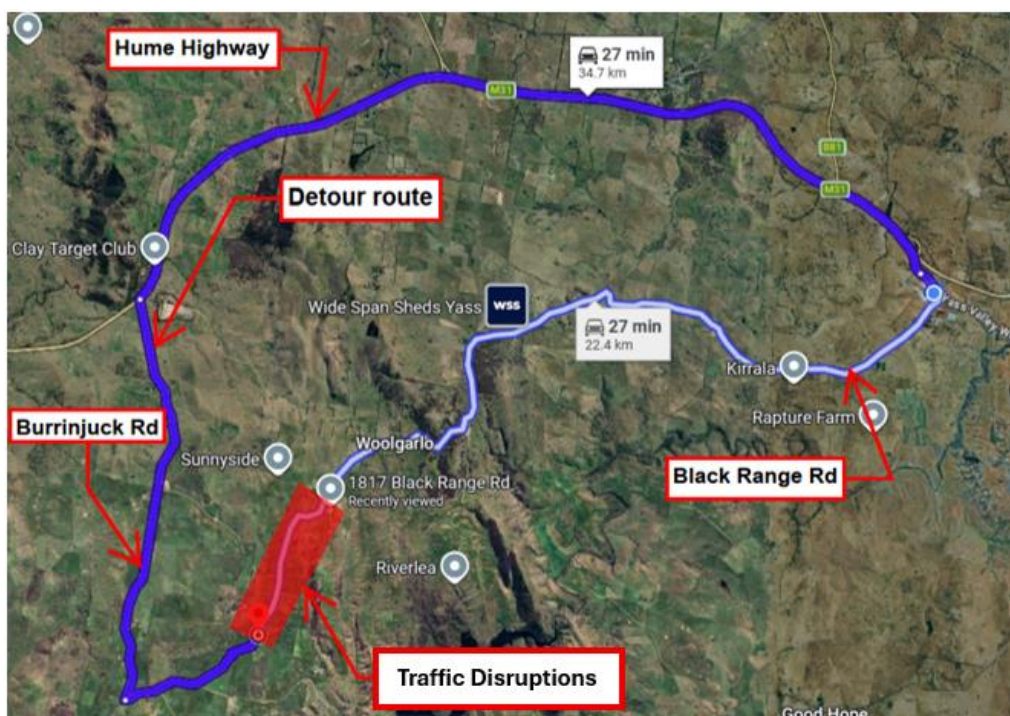


Traffic Impacts

HumeLink East will work to minimise disruption and keep delays to a minimum. Disruption will be outside school zone hours – between 10am and 2:30pm and traffic control will be in place to alert motorists of disruption and detour option.

Alternate route

A detour route around the closure is available by traveling via Burrinjuck Road and the Hume Highway as detailed below.
