

Powering Sydney's Future

Potts Hill to Alexandria transmission cable project

Sydney's population and economy are continuing to grow and with it the demand for safe and reliable electricity. TransGrid's **Powering Sydney's Future** project will secure supply with the installation of a new 20km underground cable to meet the city's future needs.

Powering Sydney's Future at a glance:

- 20 kilometres of new 330kV underground cable
- The new cable will connect substations at Potts Hill and Alexandria
- Upgrading substations at Potts Hill, Alexandria and Picnic Point
- To avoid future disruption we are proposing to install additional infrastructure to allow for a second cable at a later stage.

Project update – May 2020

The NSW Department of Planning, Industry and Environment has approved the Powering Sydney's Future project. This follows the public exhibition and submission of the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS).

TransGrid awarded the design and construct contract to global cable solutions provider, Taihan, in late December 2019. We are currently developing the detailed design for the project and progressing construction plans. Investigation works are currently underway, with main construction activity expected to start mid-year.
