Permanent road restoration on Princes Highway & May Street, St Peters

Transgrid is installing a new underground electricity cable from Potts Hill to Alexandria. The Powering Sydney's Future project will help ensure a safe, reliable and affordable energy supply for Sydney's CBD and surrounding areas. You can view a map of the cable route at www.transgrid.com.au/psf.

As you will probably be aware, we have completed a number of work activities in St Peters. From Sunday 24 October we will be doing permanent restoration of the road surface on Princes Highway, including the intersection of May Street, St Peters.

This work is expected to take up to seven nights to complete over a three week period, weather and ground conditions permitting. The noisier work will take up to five of these nights as we prepare the road surface and lay new concrete or asphalt. Highly noise intensive work will be restricted to three nights per week, with no work occurring on Friday and Saturday nights.

Please refer to map overleaf for location of work and traffic restrictions.

The remainder of May Street road surface will be permanently restored at a later stage in consultation with Inner West Council. You will receive further information before this work is done.

Work activities

- > Installing temporary fencing and safety barriers.
- > Delivering plant and equipment to site.
- > Saw cutting & hammering.
- > Grinding the road surface.
- > Laying asphalt / concrete on the road.
- > Line marking.



How will the work affect you?

- May Street will be closed to westbound traffic. Eastbound traffic on May Street will be maintained. Traffic accessing May Street from Princes Highway will use Goodsell Street or Campbell Road only. Refer to map below.
- > May Lane will remain open under traffic control.
- > Parking on May Street and Princes Highway near the work locations will be temporarily removed while road restoration is in progress.
- > Traffic control will be in place for the safety of workers and road users.
- > The work will be noisy at times, but we will make every effort to keep noise to a minimum and aim to complete high impact noise activities before midnight wherever possible.
- > There may be temporary closures of footpaths but we will provide an alternative route.
- > Road users may experience short delays to access local properties.
- > If your driveway access will be disrupted, we will inform you in advance and discuss arrangements.
