Work Notification | May 2025 Traffic cameras, Tarcutta

HumeLink is one of Australia's largest energy infrastructure projects connecting renewable energy sources to the grid and helping to put downward pressure on energy prices. The project consists of 365 kilometres of 500 kV overhead transmission lines connecting Wagga Wagga, Bannaby and Maragle and is being delivered in two sections.

The section between Wagga Wagga, Maragle and Wondalga is being constructed by UGL Engineering and CPB Contractors, working in joint venture as the HumeLink West JV.

About the work

We are continuing enabling work to establish access points, access tracks and work compounds, which will be used during construction of the transmission lines, and to prepare for construction of the HumeLink transmission lines at Tarcutta.

To monitor our work activities and impacts, two trailer-mounted CCTV cameras have been installed on either side of the Hume Highway at Tarcutta.

The purpose of the CCTV cameras is for traffic counts only, and it will not be used to acquire or store any personal information.

What you can expect

The CCTV cameras will be in operation intermittently for short periods during HumeLink West construction over the next two years. The camera will record traffic counts for vehicles on the Hume Highway.

When we are working

Work to maintain and relocate the cameras will take place during standard construction hours of **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday** and **8am to 6pm on Saturdays and Sundays and public holidays**. If work out of these hours is required, we will contact you at least seven days before the work starts.

Where we will be working

The trailer-mounted CCTV cameras will be located on either side of the Hume Highway at Tarcutta, shown in the map over the page.
