

# Powering Sydney's Future

## POTTS HILL TO ALEXANDRIA TRANSMISSION CABLE PROJECT COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

### Night and all weekend trenching work at Sydenham Road and Centennial Street, Marrickville

TransGrid is installing a new underground electricity cable from Potts Hill to Alexandria. The Powering Sydney's Future project will help ensure a safe, reliable and affordable electricity supply for Sydney's CBD and surrounding areas. Trenching work on **Sydenham Road, Marrickville**, near the intersection of **Centennial Street**, will start from **Thursday 29 April**. Please refer to the map overleaf for the location of the work site. This work needs to be completed outside of standard construction hours due to high daytime traffic volumes.

#### Work activities

- > Delivering plant and equipment to site.
- > Trimming trees to create a safe distance from plant and equipment (conducted by a trained arborist).
- > Cutting the road surface with a concrete saw.
- > Digging a trench about two metres wide using an excavator and installing conduits (pipes).
- > Using a pump/vacuum truck as required.
- > Backfilling the trench and covering it with steel plates.
- > Temporarily restoring the road surface to allow normal traffic flow.

#### Work hours

The work hours for this trenching work will be from **Thursday 29 April at 6pm to Friday 30 April at 6am**, and then around the clock on the weekend from **Friday 30 April at 6pm through until Monday 3 May at 6am**. All work is weather and ground conditions permitting.

We have also planned for a backup weekend for this work. **If required**, the backup weekend would see work start **Friday 7 May at 6pm** continuing until **Monday 10 May at 6am**. We would use this weekend if we do not finish the work required on the first weekend, or if construction is impacted by weather or ground conditions.

#### How will the work affect you?

- > **Centennial Street, between Petersham Road and Sydenham Road, will be temporarily closed to through traffic during the work.** Traffic detours and traffic control will be in place for the safety of workers and road users. Centennial Street will remain open to local residents under traffic control.
- > **Sydenham Road**, near the Centennial Street intersection, will be open to traffic but under stop/slow conditions. **Please allow extra time to travel through this intersection during the work.**
- > The work will be noisy at times, but every effort will be made to keep noise to a minimum. We aim to complete high impact noise activities before midnight on each shift wherever possible.
- > There will be a temporary loss of street parking of around 100 metres while trenching is in progress.
- > Road users may experience short delays to access local properties.
- > There may be temporary closures of footpaths, but we will provide an alternative route for pedestrians.
- > If we expect your driveway access will be disrupted, we will inform you in advance and discuss arrangements.

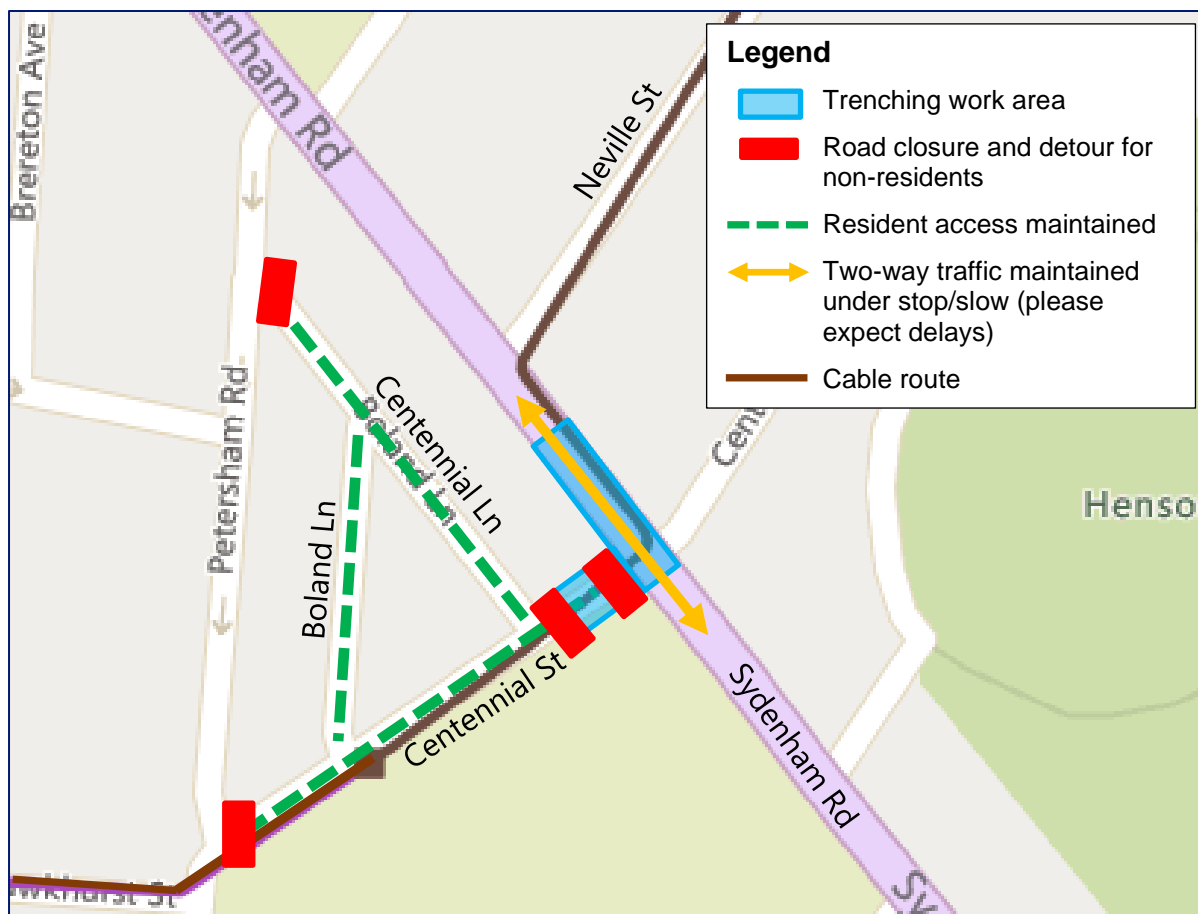

## What's next

We expect to be working on Sydenham Road and Centennial Street until June 2021 but work will not be continuous during this period.

On Centennial Street, we will continue with installing and joining cables at the recently installed joint bay, installing minor ancillary pits, and temporarily restoring the road surface. There will also be further trenching work on Sydenham Road closer to the intersection with Neville Street. We will keep you advised of these activities.

Once all work is complete in the area and the cable is installed and tested, we will permanently restore the road surface.
