Yass worker accommodation facility - earthworks

HumeLink is one of NSW largest energy infrastructure projects, with about 365 km of new 500vK transmission line which will connect Wagga Wagga, Bannaby and Maragle. The eastern portion between the existing Bannaby substation and Wondalga is being delivered by Acciona Construction Australia Pty Ltd and Genus Infrastructure (NSW) Pty Ltd in a joint venture.

Yass worker accommodation facility

To help deliver the project, a worker accommodation facility is being established in the Yass Industrial Park which will be able to house up to 300 workers when fully operational.

Construction is underway on the site, with earthmoving starting from **early May 2025**. This activity is expected to take approximately nine weeks.

What to expect

- **Construction activity** will include:
 - the use of excavators, graders and heavy machinery for earthmoving and clearing
 - machinery and equipment will generate dust, noise and vibration
 - trucks delivering equipment and materials.
- **Work hours:** construction works take place during daylight hours:
 - 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays
 - If out of hours work is required, we will contact all impacted landowners beforehand.

Where we are working

This construction work is happening on a contained site within the **Yass Industrial Park off Yass Valley Way**, near the Hume Highway service centre. The site is shown in the photo below.

Traffic and Environment

- **Additional vehicle movements:** during work there will be additional vehicle and truck movements around the site within the Yass Industrial Park during construction. Access to the site will be via Commercial and Enterprise roads.
- **Work may be noisy at times:** Every effort will be made to keep noisy work to a minimum and reduce impacts to the community.



In coming weeks, there will be more heavy machinery working in the Yass Industrial Park site.

What will happen next

Once the site has been cleared and earthmoving is completed, the next stage will include:

- delivery of temporary accommodation modules (cabins) to the site (expected from **June 2025**)
- additional vehicle movements as accommodation modules are delivered by trucks
- installation of the accommodation modules.

Other upcoming work includes:

- utility works to connect the site to power, water, wastewater and any other service, as required
- establishment of temporary fencing, lighting, fire protection, erosion and sediment controls
- establishment of construction infrastructure for the temporary office and accommodation facilities.
