Assembly and erection of towers in Upper Lachlan Shire

HumeLink is one of NSW largest energy infrastructure projects, with about 365 km of new 500kV transmission line which will connect Wagga Wagga, Bannaby and Maragle. The eastern portion between the existing Bannaby substation and Wondalga is being delivered by Acciona Construction Australia Pty Ltd and Genus Infrastructure (NSW) Pty Ltd in a joint venture as AG JV HumeLink East.

Tower assembly and erection to begin in Upper Lachlan Shire

Assembly and erection of transmission towers on HumeLink East began in the Adjungbilly-Tumut area in December 2025. Work on transmission towers is now starting in the Upper Lachlan Shire in **February 2026**. The first towers in the region will be assembled and erected near **Gurrundah** and **Bannister**.

While tower construction is underway, we will also be continuing work to construct access points and tracks and foundations along the project alignment.

What to expect

During these works, there will be increased heavy vehicle and semi-trailer movements as steel components are delivered to site for tower erection.

- **Construction activity** will include:
 - the use of excavators and heavy machinery for earthmoving and clearing
 - excavation with piling rigs to drill and prepare tower foundations
 - concrete work and pouring to prepare tower foundations
 - large cranes will be used to assemble and lift tower sections
 - trucks delivering equipment and materials
 - ongoing surveying and monitoring of biodiversity, heritage, noise, dust and vegetation including aerial surveys by drone.

All work will be carried out in line with the project [Conditions of Approval](#) available on the NSW Government [Major Projects website](#) planning portal.

When we will be working

- **Work hours:** construction works take place during daylight hours:
 - 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.
 - If nightwork or out-of-hours work is required, we will contact all impacted landowners beforehand.

Traffic and Environment

- **Additional vehicle movements:** during work there will be additional vehicle and truck movements around the site during construction including on Bannister Lane.
- **Work may be noisy at times:** we will do everything we can to minimise any impacts such as turning off equipment and vehicles when they are not being used
- A water cart may be used for dust suppression on any unsealed roads that are used for deliveries.

Where we will be working

The assembly and erection of the first towers in the Upper Lachlan Shire will be assembled and erected near **Gurrundah** and **Bannister**, close to Bannister Lane. See the map below. You can also check the interactive map for all work locations at transgrid.com.au/humelink#Project-map



HumeLink East water usage

The HumeLink East is mindful of our water usage on the project during the current drought conditions. Water sources and locations have been determined in consultation with councils. Where possible, HumeLink East uses wastewater or recycled water for construction activities including dust suppression.
