



Fact sheet Adjungbilly Worker Accommodation Facility November 2025

What is HumeLink?

HumeLink is one of NSW largest energy infrastructure projects and will deliver about 365 kilometres of new 500vK transmission line connecting Wagga Wagga, Bannaby and Maragle. The eastern portion between the existing Bannaby substation and Wondalga is known as HumeLink East, and is being delivered in a joint venture by Acciona Construction Australia Pty Ltd and Genus Infrastructure (NSW) Pty Ltd.

Adjungbilly worker accommodation facility

Two accommodation facilities have been built to house HumeLink East workers close to construction areas, reducing pressure on local accommodation and roads. The Adjungbilly workers accommodation facility is 22 kilometres east of Gundagai and will accommodate up to 190 workers, at full capacity. A second workers accommodation facility has been established at Yass and can accommodate another 300 workers.

The Adjungbilly worker accommodation facility welcomed its first occupants to site in **September 2025.**

Community benefits

Providing this purpose-built accommodation for workers helps minimise potential impacts on short-term accommodation availability in nearby towns for tourists and the rental market, and potential flow-on effects on housing affordability.

The accommodation's proximity to where construction will be happening also reduces travel times to sites, minimising road and traffic impacts.

On-site facilities

Due to its location, the Adjungbilly workers accommodation facility is designed to be self-sufficient. It provides quality facilities for workers to ensure they're comfortable while living and working away from home.

All bedrooms have their own bathroom, TV and air conditioning.

The site also includes a fully equipped gym, kitchen and dining room, a recreation room, tavern, medical room, wi-fi and office space.

Location

The accommodation is located at Adjungbilly off Gobarralong Adjungbilly Road, east of Gundagai.

There are dedicated parking spaces available for project light vehicles on the site.

Environment

The Adjungbilly workers accommodation facility has stringent measures in place to reduce environmental impacts:

- Saving energy: Workers are encouraged to turn off lights, air conditioners, heaters and electronics when not in use and to keep windows and doors closed when cooling or heating is on.
- Saving water: Workers will help save water by limiting shower times and not leaving taps running unnecessarily.
- **Reducing waste:** Measures to reduce on-site waste include recycling and organics bins and encouraging workers to reduce food waste.

After the project finishes

The Adjungbilly workers accommodation facility is made up of modular buildings designed to be temporary and will be removed at the end of the project. The site will then be returned to a condition agreed with the landholder.
