

Monthly Construction Update

August 2025

Upcoming construction on HumeLink East

Construction during August 2025 includes:

- Final preparation for major construction works, pending necessary planning approvals.
- Continue construction of laydown and turn around bays along the alignment for materials and equipment deliveries.
- Access points and tracks will continue to be constructed along the alignment.
- Civil works are continuing at Bannaby substation for office and laydown yard.
- Final work on the fit-out of Adjungbilly worker accommodation facility and construction of the fuel farm and workshop on the site, ahead of the opening of the accommodation facility in late August.
- Establishing fuel farm, workshop and office at Yass worker accommodation facility.

What to expect

- **Construction activities:** use of excavators and other heavy machinery for earthworks, road sealing works and clearing access tracks. Trucks delivering equipment and materials.
- **Work hours:** construction works take place during daylight hours - 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays. If work is required beyond these hours, we will contact all impacted landowners beforehand.
- **Work may be noisy at times:** we will do everything we can to minimise any impacts, such as turning off equipment and vehicles when they are not being used.

Traffic and Environment

As work ramps up, there will be an increase in HumeLink East vehicles traveling along local roads and near construction sites.

- **Yass Valley Way, Yass Industrial Park:** for delivery of modular buildings to the Yass worker accommodation facility. Site access will be via Commercial and Enterprise roads.
- **Adjungbilly Roads:** Increased traffic on roads in the Adjungbilly area, as the Adjungbilly worker accommodation facility gets commissioned and prepared for opening.

Survey inspections

Property condition assessment surveys are continuing to be conducted on properties and roads that will be accessed for the construction of the project.

- **Drones and a 3D scanner** mounted on a vehicle are being used to inspect roads and structures.
- **Approved drone flights** are occurring above construction sites weekly to monitor progress.

Heritage and ecology surveys will also continue this month, along with ground investigation and earth resistivity testing to help inform the design of the transmission towers.

Adjungbilly worker accommodation facility

The Adjungbilly worker accommodation facility is nearing completion. Modular accommodation buildings and related infrastructure have been installed, and the site will be ready for occupation by late August 2025.

Equipment and material deliveries

This month, we will be relocating stringing equipment from Sydney to designated laydown areas in Yass and Adjungbilly to support upcoming works.

In addition, deliveries of key materials, including gravel and drainage pipes, will be ongoing to facilitate the development of access points and tracks across the alignment.
