What is HumeLink?

HumeLink is one of NSW largest energy infrastructure projects, with about 365 kilometres of new 500vK transmission line which will connect Wagga Wagga, Bannaby and Maragle. The eastern portion, known as HumeLink East, between the existing Bannaby substation and Wondalga, is being delivered by Acciona Construction Australia Pty Ltd and Genus Infrastructure (NSW) Pty Ltd in a joint venture.

Construction deliveries ramping up

Main construction of HumeLink East is now underway and deliveries of tower structures, concrete and lifting equipment will ramp up from **November 2025**. There will be an increased number of project vehicles on local roads including trucks transporting gravel, cement, water and construction materials.

When deliveries will be happening

Deliveries and heavy vehicle movements will take place during standard construction hours of 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.

Both light and heavy vehicle movements may also take place outside standard construction hours, where impacts are negligible or where impacted residents have been separately notified.

Traffic control

Motorists may experience some delays during construction. Traffic control will be in place when required, including temporary land closures and traffic lights, variable message signs, boom gates, signage and speed reductions.

Please keep to the signposted speed limits, follow the direction of traffic controllers, and drive to the conditions.

There may also be short-term restrictions on access near tower sites and crossings. We will ensure property access is maintained wherever possible.

Safety around heavy vehicles

Keep in mind that due to their weight and size, heavy vehicles take a lot longer to stop, so please give them space.

Heavy vehicles can also have bigger blind spots, so truck drivers may not be able to see you.

Trucks also have a much wider turning circle, so please be careful when driving next to or behind a truck, especially at intersections.

Heavy vehicle routes for HumeLink East

Heavy vehicles will be operating on local roads throughout construction and may travel in convoy to deliver materials and equipment. We will make every effort to minimise impacts and maintain safety by:

- minimising the number of machines and vehicles to be used and ensuring all vehicles are maintained and serviced
- limiting project traffic speed to a maximum of 80 km/h
- holding mandatory driver safety training and using in-vehicle monitoring and management systems.
