

Monthly Construction Update

July 2025

Upcoming construction on HumeLink East

Construction during July 2025 includes:

- Bulk earthworks and civil works are continuing at Bannaby substation
- Delivery of modular buildings to the Yass worker accommodation facility
- Final work on fit-out of worker accommodation facility and construction of fuel farm and workshop at Adjungbilly
- Access points and tracks will continue to be constructed along the alignment between Yass and Tumut.

What to expect

- **Construction activities:** use of excavators and other heavy machinery for earthworks, road sealing and clearing access tracks. Trucks delivering equipment and materials.
- **Work hours:** construction works take place between 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays. If nightwork is required, we will contact all impacted landowners beforehand.
- **Out of hours work:** there will be an extension to the out of hours work happening at the Yass worker accommodation facility from early July to early October 2025, with extended working hours between 6am to 6pm, Monday to Sunday.
- **Work may be noisy at times:** we will do everything we can to minimise any impacts, such as turning off equipment and vehicles when they are not being used.

Traffic and Environment

As work ramps up, there will be an increase in heavy vehicles traveling along local roads and near construction sites:

- **Yass Valley Way, Yass Industrial Park:** for delivery of modular buildings to the Yass worker accommodation facility. Site access will be via Commercial and Enterprise roads.
- **Snowy Mountains Highway and Gocup Road, Gocup, adjacent to Meadow Creek Road:** traffic control is currently on site to allow for deliveries and will be in place until early August 2025.

Survey inspections

Property condition assessment surveys are continuing to be conducted on properties and roads that will be accessed for the construction of the project.

- **Drones and a 3D scanner** mounted on a vehicle are being used to inspect roads and structures.
- **Approved drone flights** will occur weekly above construction sites to monitor progress.

Heritage and ecology surveys will also continue this month, along with ground investigation and earth resistivity testing to help inform the design of the transmission towers.

Adjungbilly worker accommodation facility

The Adjungbilly worker accommodation facility is nearing completion. All modular accommodation buildings and related infrastructure have been installed, and the site will be ready for occupation by early August 2025.

Access tracks and water crossings underway

As part of works to establish access tracks and points, our teams have also been working to build new water crossings rated to carry heavy vehicles, including the one below at Bookham, south-west of Yass. Crossings like this will enable us to safely transport equipment and materials to site and minimise disruptions.
