

Work Notification

Large truck movement in Forest Hill and Gregadoo – 28 May 2026

Elizabeth Avenue, Gregadoo East Road and Livingstone Gully Road

As part of the HumeLink West project, a large truck and trailer measuring approximately 50 metres long and 4.2 metres wide will be travelling from Port Kembla to Gugaa 500 kV substation via Forest Hill and Gregadoo to deliver electrical equipment on **Thursday 28 May 2026**. Should there be any changes to the schedule due to operational requirements, updated information will be shared.

Due to its size, the vehicle will be escorted by NSW Police. The truck and trailer will be transporting a shunt reactor, which will be installed at the Gugaa 500 kV substation in Gregadoo.

The route of the truck and trailer in Forest Hill and Gregadoo will be:

- Sturt Highway
- left onto Elizabeth Avenue
- left onto Gregadoo East Road
- right onto Livingstone Gully Road

This delivery is the first of eleven scheduled transformer and reactor deliveries to the Gugaa substation. Further deliveries will take place throughout May, June and July, weather and construction conditions permitting.

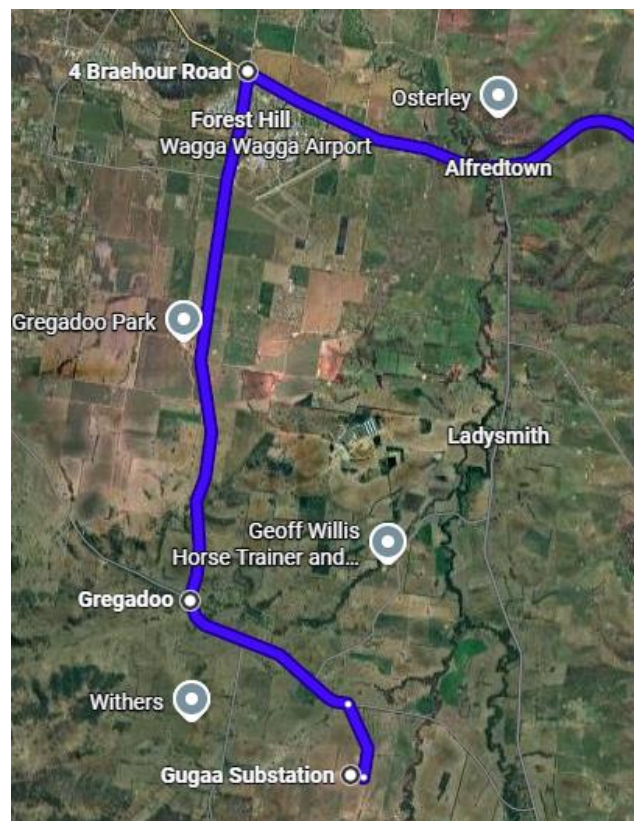
