

Work Notification

Large truck movements in Forest Hill and Gregadoo – May - July

Elizabeth Avenue, Gregadoo East Road and Livingstone Gully Road

We would like to inform you that, as part of the HumeLink West project, large trucks and trailers measuring approximately 50 metres long and 4.2 metres wide will be travelling from Port Kembla to Gugaa 500 kV substation via Forest Hill and Gregadoo to deliver electrical equipment. Due to their size, these vehicles will be escorted by NSW Police. The trucks will be transporting a total of eleven substation transformers and reactors, which will be installed at the Gugaa substation in Gregadoo.

The route of the truck and trailer in Forest Hill and Gregadoo will be:

- Sturt Highway
- left onto Elizabeth Avenue
- left onto Gregadoo East Road
- right onto Livingstone Gully Road

Deliveries of transformers and reactors will take place throughout May and June until July, weather and construction conditions permitting.

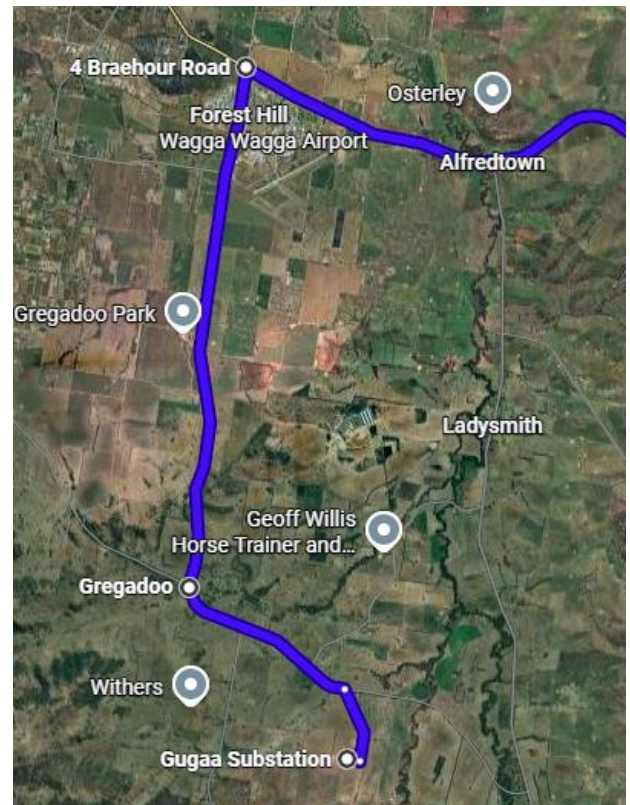
