## POTTS HILL TO ALEXANDRIA TRANSMISSION CABLE PROJECT COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

### Upcoming work on Bedwin Road cable bridge, Newtown and St Peters

TransGrid is installing a new underground electricity cable from Potts Hill to Alexandria. The Powering Sydney's Future project will help ensure a safe, reliable and affordable electricity supply for Sydney's CBD and surrounding areas. A bridge is required for the new cable to cross the railway. The bridge will also provide a cycleway link for the Inner West community. The first concrete beam for the cable bridge was successfully installed during night work on Wednesday 24 February. This notice is to advise of an upcoming program of weekend work to install the next precast beams.

A series of crane lifts for the concrete beams and concrete pouring will occur all weekend, from **Friday 5 March 2021 at 6pm, until Sunday 7 March 2021 at 7pm**.

To deliver this work safely, a series of traffic measures will be introduced in the local area:

- Partial lane closures on Bedwin Road bridge, with traffic in both directions using the same traffic lanes (under stop/go conditions).
- Temporary road closure and parking removal on Edgware Road (loop section under Bedwin Road bridge).
- Temporary parking removal to accommodate a temporary bus stop on Murray Street (opposite Marrickville Metro).

The map overleaf shows these temporary traffic measures required during work.

#### Work activities

- > Setting up cranes on Edgware Road and in Camdenville Park.
- > Lifting the precast beams into place over rail corridor with these cranes.
- > Pouring concrete on the bridge deck.
- > Removing the cranes from Edgware Road and Camdenville Park when the lift is completed.

#### Work hours

Work will be completed from **6pm Friday 5 March to 7pm Sunday 7 March**.

#### How will the work affect you?

- > A full road closure of **Edgware Road** under Bedwin Road Bridge, including temporary loss of parking.
- > There will be lane closures on **Bedwin Road Bridge**. Traffic flow will be maintained via contra-flow.
- > Potential light spill from the work. However, our crews will seek to limit this impact as much as possible.
- > Intermittent noise may be heard from the work site, particularly during the crane lift and general use of construction equipment.
- > Traffic control will be in place to safely direct vehicles and pedestrians around the sites.
- > Parking will be removed for about 70 metres on Murray Street to accommodate diverted buses.
- > Parking will be removed on Edgware Road under Bedwin Road Bridge.
- > Resident access will be maintained but road users may experience temporary delays in accessing local properties.
