

## Work Notification | June 2025

### Bannaby substation civil works begin

HumeLink is one of NSW largest energy infrastructure projects, with about 365 km of new 500kV transmission line which will connect Wagga Wagga, Bannaby and Maragle. The eastern portion between the existing Bannaby substation and Wondalga is being delivered by Acciona Construction Australia Pty Ltd and Genus Infrastructure (NSW) Pty Ltd in a joint venture as AG JV HumeLink East.

#### Bannaby substation upgrade works

As part of HumeLink East, we are expanding and upgrading Transgrid's existing 500 kV substation at Bannaby. Civil Work on the site will get underway in **early June 2025** and continue for the next six to nine months.

Initial works will include fencing, bulk earthworks and the establishment of access tracks for machinery.

#### What to expect

- **Construction activity** will include:
  - the use of excavators and heavy machinery for earthmoving and clearing
  - trucks delivering equipment and materials.
- **Work hours:** construction work takes place during daylight hours:
  - 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.
  - If nightwork is required, we will contact all impacted landowners beforehand.

#### Where we are working

The work is happening adjacent to Transgrid's existing substation on Hanworth Road, Bannaby.

## Traffic and Environment

Traffic impacts for the public are expected to be minimal, but you may notice:

- **Additional vehicle movements:**

During work, there will be additional vehicle and truck movements on **Bannaby Road** and **Hanworth Road**, Bannaby. These will be infrequent over the next six months from June 2025.

## What are we doing

The existing Bannaby substation is being expanded to accommodate the new 500 kV transmission lines as part of the HumeLink project.

This work will include:

- extending the substation bench (foundation)
- modifying electrical equipment, footings, steelwork, drainage and external fencing
- constructing a new access road for the extension of the substation.
