

Monthly Construction Update June 2025

Upcoming construction on HumeLink East

Construction during June 2025 includes:

- Start of upgrade works at Transgrid’s existing Bannaby Substation, including bulk earthworks and preliminary civil works.
- Access points and tracks will continue to be constructed along the alignment between Yass to Tumut.
- Continue constructing the Adjungbilly worker accommodation facility carrying out fit out of buildings, establishing fuel farm and workshop.
- Completion of earthworks at Yass worker accommodation facility and start of construction of the accommodation facilities.

What to expect

- **Construction activities:** use of excavators and other heavy machinery for earthworks, road sealing works and clearing access tracks. Trucks delivering equipment and materials.
 - **Work hours:** construction works take place during daylight hours - 7am to 6pm from Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays. If nightwork is required, we will contact all impacted landowners beforehand.
- Work may be noisy at times:** we will do everything we can to minimise any impacts such as turning off equipment and vehicles when they are not being used.

Traffic and Environment

As work ramps up, there will be an increase in HumeLink East vehicles traveling along local roads and near construction sites.

- **Yass Valley Way, Yass Industrial Park:** to prepare the Yass worker accommodation facility. Site access will be via Commercial and Enterprise roads.

Ground Investigations and earth testing continue, using a borehole drill to collect soil and rock samples. This will help determine actual ground conditions to inform the design of transmission tower foundations.

Survey inspections

Property condition assessment surveys are continuing to be conducted on properties and roads that will be accessed for the construction of the project.

- **Drones and a 3D scanner** mounted on a vehicle are being used to inspect roads and structures.
- **Approved drone flights:** we are also flying above construction sites weekly to monitor progress.
