### Assembly and erection of towers between Bannaby and Pejar Dam

#### Tower assembly and erection work between Bannaby and Pejar Dam

Construction on HumeLink East is moving into the next stage in the northern section of the project between Bannaby and Pejar Dam, with the start of work to assemble and erect transmission towers. Steel tower components are being delivered to sites across the area, with the first tower assembly to begin near **Middle Arm** from **30 July 2026**.

#### What to expect

During these works, there will be heavy vehicle and semi-trailer movements as steel components are delivered to site so towers can be built. Construction activity will include:

- use of excavators and heavy machinery for earthmoving and clearing
- concrete formwork and pouring to prepare tower foundations
- use of large cranes to assemble and lift tower sections
- trucks delivering equipment and materials
- ongoing surveys and monitoring of biodiversity, heritage, noise, dust and vegetation including the use of drones.

We are also continuing work to construct access points, access tracks and tower foundations along the project alignment.

All work will be carried out in line with the project's [Conditions of Approval](#) available on the NSW Government [Major Projects website](#) planning portal. Mitigations will be put in place to minimise dust, noise and vibration caused by construction activities.

#### When we will be working

Construction works take place between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**.

If nightwork or out-of-hours work is required, we will contact all impacted landowners beforehand.



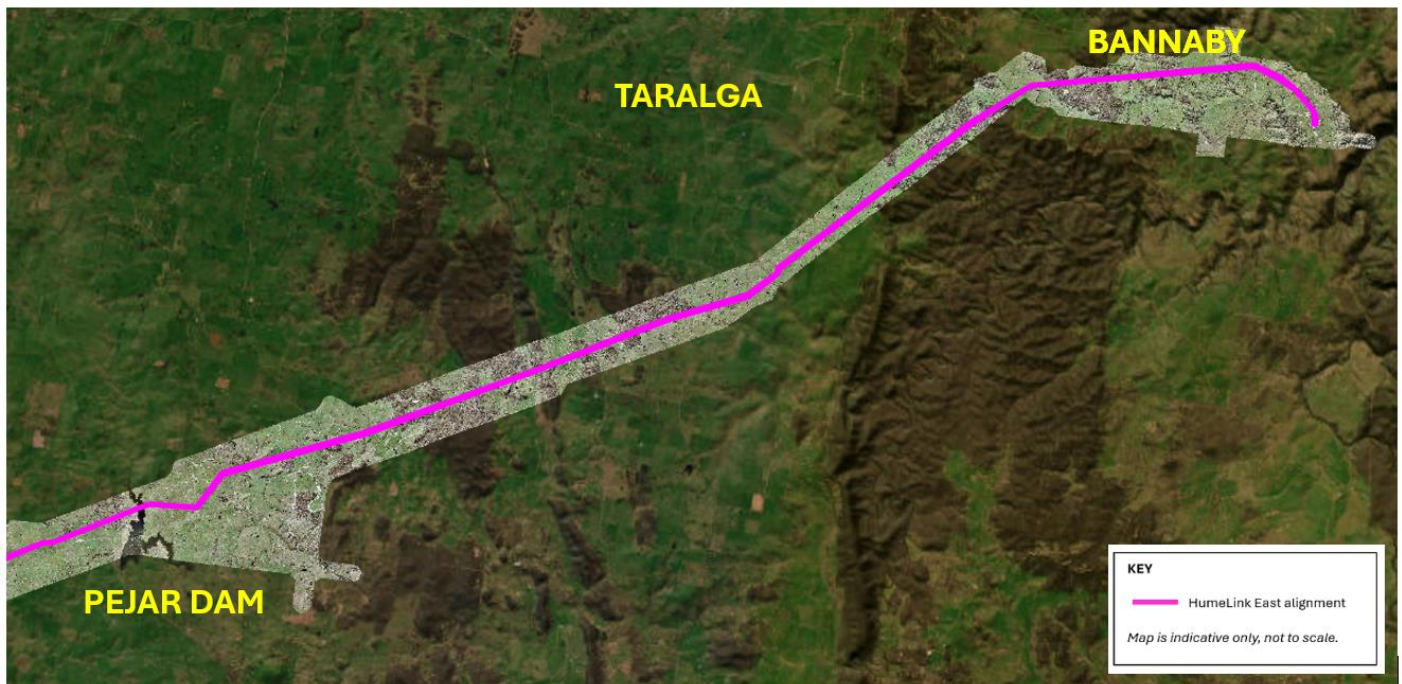
Examples of tower assembly and erection near Adjungbilly for HumeLink East

#### Traffic and Environment

- **Additional vehicle movements:** during work there will be increased vehicle and truck movements around the area during construction, including on **Bannaby Road**, **Taralga Road** and **Woodhouselee Road**.
- **Work may be noisy at times:** we will do everything we can to minimise any impacts such as turning off equipment and vehicles when they are not being used.

## Where we will be working
