POTTS HILL TO ALEXANDRIA TRANSMISSION CABLE PROJECT COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

Out-of-hours underbore at Hanks Street and Queen Street, Ashfield

TransGrid is installing a new underground electricity cable from Potts Hill to Alexandria. The Powering Sydney's Future project will help ensure a safe, reliable and affordable energy supply for Sydney's CBD and surrounding areas. You can view a map of the cable route at www.transgrid.com.au/psf

Work at **Hanks Street, Ashfield** will involve underbore drilling passing beneath Queen Street. The work will generate noise, with the noisiest activities being drilling, pumping and vacuuming.

Work in this location is due to start in **late February 2021** and will take around five weeks to complete (weather permitting). The work will require approximately 30 shifts to complete, including 10 out-of-hours shifts on Saturdays and Sundays.

The work will be carried out on **day shifts, Monday to Sunday, from 7am to 6pm.**

How will the work affect you?

- > **There will be around 10 shifts** of out-of-hours construction work completed on Saturday & Sunday.
- > Highly noise intensive work carried out on Saturday & Sunday will be done for three hours at a time, followed by one hour of respite.
- > There will be temporary/intermittent road closures to through traffic on **Hanks Street** during the work. Traffic detours and traffic control will be in place for the safety of workers and road users. **Hanks Street** will remain open to local residents under traffic control.
- > There will be a temporary loss of street parking on both sides of Hanks Street while work is in progress.
- > Road users may experience short delays to access local properties.
- > If we expect your driveway access will be disrupted, we will inform you in advance and discuss arrangements.

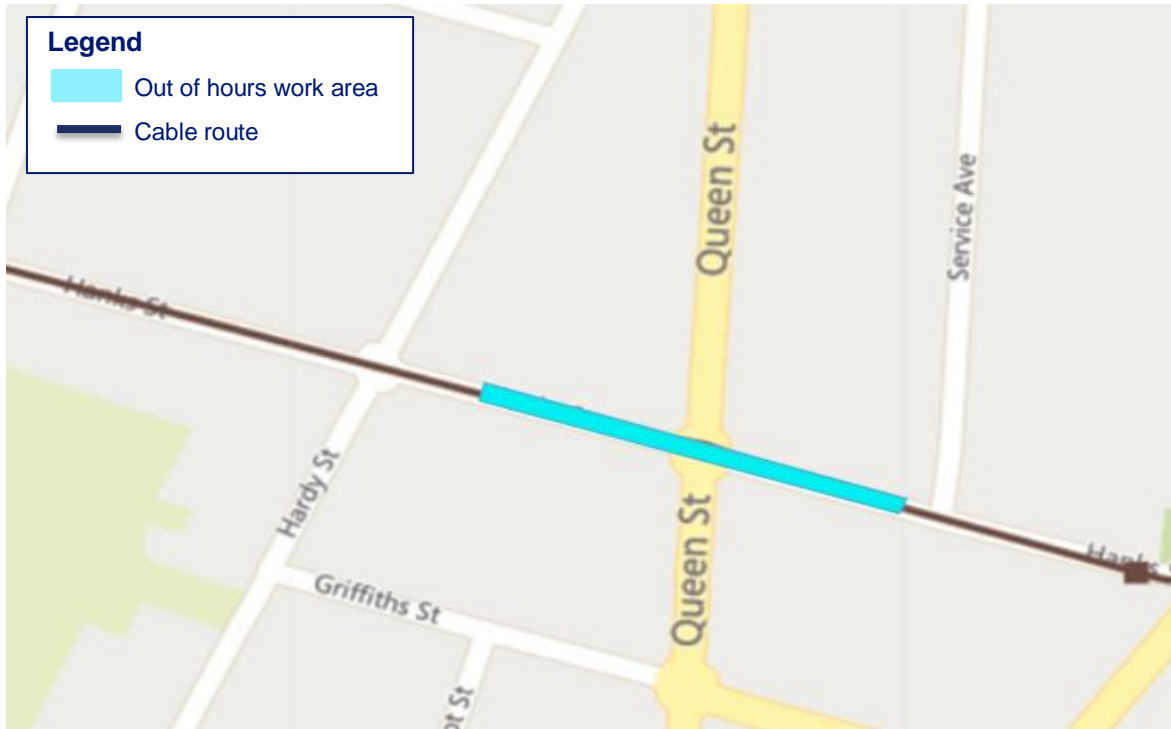
