Construction of cable bridge at Muir Road, Chullora

Piling work to start

TransGrid is installing a new underground electricity cable from Potts Hill to Alexandria. The Powering Sydney's Future project will help ensure a safe, reliable and affordable energy supply for Sydney's CBD and surrounding areas. You can view a map of the cable route at www.transgrid.com.au/psf

Piling work to drill the foundations for the new cable bridge at **Muir Road**, **Chullora** is due to start from **Monday**, **31 August 2020** and will take around two weeks, weather and ground conditions permitting.

A large piling rig will begin operating on the eastern side of the railway cutting, near Anzac Street. The rig will then switch to the western side, near Dasea Street (see map overleaf).

Work activities

- > Setting up the rig and establishing a safety zone.
- > Drilling deep holes into the ground and removing spoil from site.
- > Setting up and using mobile cranes to lift equipment.
- > Setting up concrete pumps.
- > Pouring concrete into the holes to form piles.

We will continue to keep you updated on specific work activities throughout the bridge construction.

Work hours

Standard work hours are **7am – 6pm**, **Monday to Friday** and **8am – 1pm on Saturdays**. The rig will be delivered and moved outside these hours to minimise impacts on traffic and meet road safety requirements.

How will the work affect you?

- > Piling work can generate high levels of noise, which we will make every effort to keep to a minimum.
- > There will be a temporary loss of street parking while work is in progress.
- > There will be temporary lane closures to ensure the safety of workers and road users. Traffic control will be in place to safely direct traffic around the site.
- > Access to properties will be maintained.


