

Proposed Out of Hours Work Notice

Notification of Extension to Out of Hours Work at Adjungbilly Accommodation Facility, Weekends from 9 August 2025 to 13 September 2025, 8:00am – 6:00pm (weather dependent)

Dear Resident,

As part of the HumeLink East Project, we are proposing to undertake some out of hours work at the Adjungbilly Accommodation Facility to minimise community impacts, improve worker safety, and complete construction more efficiently.

We are seeking your agreement to extend working hours at the site on weekends as outlined below. A schedule of the proposed activities is attached.

Proposed Out of Hours Work

Current approved working hours:

- Monday to Friday: 7:00am – 6:00pm
- Saturday: 8:00am – 1:00pm

Proposed extended working hours:

- Saturday 8:00am – 6:00pm
- Sunday 8:00am – 6:00pm

Extending work hours will help us complete construction of the compound and laydown area. This will reduce the overall period of disruption to the local community.

All out of hours activities will be closely monitored for compliance with noise and environmental management plans. You will receive at least 48 hours' notice before any out of hours work occurs.

What to Expect

A noise assessment has identified that your property may experience minimal noise impacts during these activities.

Out of hours work will involve:

- Hand tools (hammers, battery drills, battery blowers, battery rattle guns, cardboard cutters)
- Light vehicles
- Small, acoustically-shielded generators
- Radios and ladders

To assist with mitigating any potential noise impacts:

- there will be a limited amount of machinery working at the same time
- machines will be shielded, where possible, and turned off when not in use.
- all machinery and vehicles will be maintained and serviced.
