Yass worker accommodation module deliveries

HumeLink is one of NSW largest energy infrastructure projects, with about 365 km of new 500vK transmission line which will connect Wagga Wagga, Bannaby and Maragle. The eastern portion between the existing Bannaby substation and Wondalga is being delivered by Acciona Construction Australia Pty Ltd and Genus Infrastructure (NSW) Pty Ltd in a joint venture.

Yass worker accommodation facility

To help deliver the project, a worker accommodation facility is being established within the **Yass Industrial Park off Yass Valley Way**, near the Hume Highway service centre. It will house up to 300 workers when operational.

Construction of the facility is now underway. From **July 2025**, deliveries will begin of modular accommodation buildings. Each module contains four self-contained en-suite rooms, and a total of 80 modules will be delivered to site. Weather dependent, these deliveries are due to be completed by the end of **August 2025**.

What to expect

- **Construction activity** will include:
 - trucks delivering equipment and materials
 - machinery moving accommodation modules into position on site.
- **Work hours:** construction works take place during daylight hours:
 - 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays

Traffic and Environment

The modules are being transport from Port Kembla to Yass by truck. During July and August. you can expect:

- **Additional vehicle movements** along the Hume Highway and Yass Valley Way, for delivery of accommodation modules. Access to the site will be via Commercial and Enterprise roads.
- Deliveries are being made in the middle of the day, to avoid busy periods on local roads.

What will happen next

Once delivery of the accommodation modules has finished, work will continue on completing the rest of the accommodation facility.

Other upcoming work includes:

- utility works to connect the site to power, water, wastewater and any other service, as required
- establishment of temporary fencing, lighting, fire protection, erosion and sediment controls
- establishment of construction infrastructure for the temporary office and accommodation facilities.
