Work Notification | December 2025 Work over the Christmas holidays

HumeLink is one of NSW largest energy infrastructure projects, with about 365 km of new 500kV transmission line which will connect Wagga Wagga, Bannaby and Maragle. The eastern portion between the existing Bannaby substation and Wondalga is being delivered by Acciona Construction Australia Pty Ltd and Genus Infrastructure (NSW) Pty Ltd in a joint venture as AG JV HumeLink East.

Christmas and New Year shutdown period

HumeLink East project offices will be shut from the close of business on **19 December 2025** and will be reopen from **5 January 2026**, however some construction work will still be proceeding during the break.

What work will still be happening?

- 23-28 December 2025: no work will be happening on project sites
- 29 December 2025: construction will resume including drilling tower foundations and assembling towers. If work continues near you, the HumeLink East Community team will be in contact with you.
- Construction activity will include:
 - o the use of excavators and heavy machinery for earthmoving and clearing
 - o machinery and equipment will generate dust, noise and vibration
 - o additional vehicle and truck movements to deliver equipment and materials.
 - o excavation with piling rigs to drill and prepare tower foundations
 - o concrete work and pouring to prepare tower foundations
 - o large cranes will be used to assemble and lift tower sections
 - ongoing surveys and monitoring of biodiversity, heritage, noise, dust and vegetation including aerial surveys by drone.
- Work hours: construction works take place during daylight hours:
 - o 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays
 - o If night or out-of-hours work is required, we will contact all impacted landowners beforehand
 - truck deliveries may take place between 7am and 6pm including on Saturdays and Sundays.
- Steel deliveries: will continue throughout December 2025 and January 2026
 - o there will be increased heavy vehicle movements as steel components are delivered to site
 - o up to 1,000 tonnes of transmission tower steel will be delivered fortnightly
 - o deliveries days do not include public holidays
 - o deliveries of steel tower components will be continuing in the following areas and roads between **19 December** and **6 January**:

Bannister/Gurrundah	Bannister Lane, Storriers Lane, Prices Lane, Gurrundah Road
Adjungbilly area	Nanangroe Road
