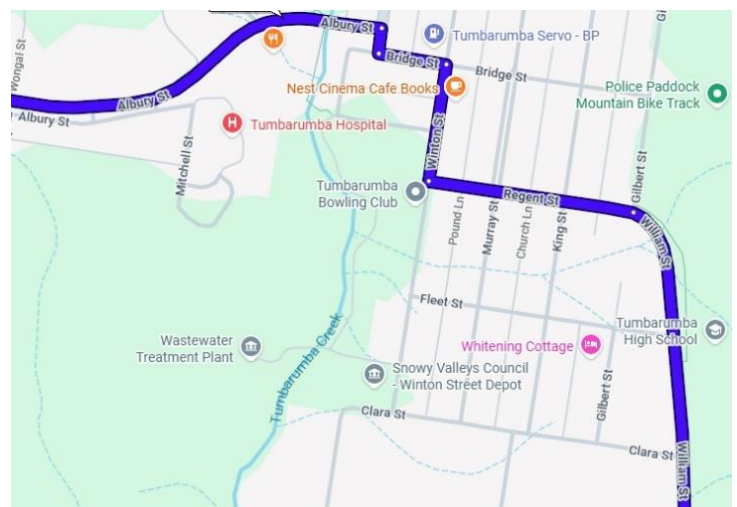
### Large truck movement in Tumbarumba – 23 April 2026

## Albury Street, Bridge Street, Winton Street, Regent Street & William Street

We would like to inform you, that as part of the HumeLink West project, a large truck and trailer measuring about 50 metres long and 4.2 metres wide will be travelling from Port Kembla to Maragle via Tumbarumba, on Thursday, 23 April 2026. The truck and trailer will be escorted by NSW Police, due to its length. It will be carrying a substation transformer weighing 125 tonnes, which will be installed at Transgrid's Maragle 500 kV substation.

The route of the truck and trailer in Tumbarumba will be:

- Albury Street
- right onto The Parade
- left onto Bridge Street
- right onto Winton Street
- left onto Regent Street
- before heading out of Tumbarumba on William Street
