POTTS HILL TO ALEXANDRIA TRANSMISSION CABLE PROJECT COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

Update on construction of a cable bridge at Bedwin Road, Newtown and St Peters

TransGrid is installing a new underground electricity cable from Potts Hill to Alexandria. The Powering Sydney's Future project will help ensure a safe, reliable and affordable electricity supply for Sydney's CBD and surrounding areas. A bridge is required for the new cable to cross the railway and the cycleway will deliver a key active transport link for the Inner West community. As you may be aware, work on the Bedwin Road cable bridge began in December 2020, and work is on schedule for completion by June 2021. With the bridge foundations complete, work is now focused on building bridge support structures in readiness for the bridge deck.

This letter is to let you know of upcoming night works at the bridge.

Next week we will position a large mobile crane within Camdenville Park to prepare to install precast beams. **On Wednesday 24 February night shift,** we will lift the precast beams from Bedwin Road into place on the new cable bridge and cycleway. This work will be completed in one shift.

Existing traffic conditions on Bedwin Road will be changed during the night work. Two-way traffic flow will be maintained, however, Bedwin Road Bridge will be partially closed and traffic in both directions will share the same traffic lanes (contraflow arrangement) managed by traffic control. This work must occur during the night shift to allow delivery of oversized precast units. While this night work is proposed on Wednesday 24 February 2021, please note it is subject to change because of weather.

In the first weekend of March 2021, similar temporary traffic changes are planned for Bedwin Road Bridge from the night of Friday 5 March until the early morning of Monday 8 March.

Work activities

- > An increase in construction vehicles travelling to and from the sites and oversized deliveries.
- > Arrival and establishment of a large mobile crane in Camdenville Park.
- > Night work: delivery, preparation and lifting of precast beams within Camdenville Park.
- > Night work: installation of traffic measures for partial road closure, and traffic control.

Work hours

Construction working hours will be **7am – 6pm, Monday to Friday.**Night work hours for the single shift on Wednesday 24 February 2021 will be **6pm – 7am.**





How will the work affect you?

- > Intermittent noise may be heard from the cable bridge sites during pick up, laydown and use of equipment.
- > There may be some noise and potential light spill from the night shift work. However, our crews will seek to limit these impacts as much as possible.
- > A partial road closure on Bedwin Road Bridge.
- > Traffic control will be in place to safely direct vehicles and pedestrians around the work area.
- > Resident access will be maintained but road users may experience temporary delays in crossing Bedwin Road Bridge and accessing local properties.
