Adjungbilly accommodation module deliveries

HumeLink is one of NSW largest energy infrastructure projects, with about 365 km of new 500vK transmission line which will connect Wagga Wagga, Bannaby and Maragle. The eastern portion between the existing Bannaby substation and Wondalga is being delivered by Acciona Construction Australia Pty Ltd and Genus Infrastructure (NSW) Pty Ltd in a joint venture as AG JV HumeLink East.

Adjungbilly worker accommodation facility takes shape

To help deliver HumeLink East, a worker accommodation facility is being established at Adjungbilly to house some of the workforce for the project. When it is completed, it will be able to house up to 200 workers.

The delivery of the building modules which will make up the worker accommodation is underway and will be **complete in June 2025**. Each accommodation module consists of three ensuite rooms. The modules are being delivered to the site by truck and the deliveries will take approximately four weeks to complete.

What to expect

- **Construction activity** will include:
 - trucks delivering equipment and materials.
- **Work hours:** construction works take place during daylight hours:
 - 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.

Traffic and Environment

The site is located on private property along Adjungbilly Road, Adjungbilly about 21.7 km east of Gundagai.

During May 2025, you can expect increased truck and vehicle movements along:

- **Adjungbilly Road:** for the delivery of accommodation modules to the site.
- deliveries are being made mid-morning to avoid fog and busy periods on local roads.

What will happen next

Once delivery of the accommodation modules is completed, work will continue on completing the rest of the accommodation facility.

Other upcoming work includes:

- utility works to connect the site to power, water, wastewater and any other service, as required
- establishment of temporary fencing, lighting, fire protection, erosion and sediment controls
- establishment of construction infrastructure for the temporary office and accommodation facilities.
