POTTS HILL TO ALEXANDRIA TRANSMISSION CABLE PROJECT

COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

Permanent restoration work at Edgeware Road, Newtown and Llewellyn Street, Marrickville.

TransGrid is installing a new underground electricity cable from Potts Hill to Alexandria. The Powering Sydney's Future project will help ensure a safe, reliable and affordable energy supply for Sydney's CBD and surrounding areas. This letter is to advise you of permanent restoration work on **Edgeware Road and Llewellyn Street**, which will be the final stage of project work in your area. Thank you very much for your patience throughout the project.

Restoration work will start from **Monday 20 September 2021** and is expected to be completed in **early October 2021**, weather, ground conditions and COVID-19 restrictions permitting. Work will not be continuous during this period and night work will be limited to three nights in a week.

At times there will be traffic changes as shown on the map overleaf.

Work activities

Restoration work will involve:

- > Installing temporary fencing and safety barriers.
- > Delivering plant and equipment to site.
- > Trimming trees to create a safe distance from plant and equipment (directed by a qualified arborist).
- > Tree planting.
- > Saw cutting & hammering.
- > Profiling the road a large machine will grind off existing asphalt/concrete before a new surface is laid.
- > Using a pump/vacuum truck to remove water as required.
- > Laying concrete and asphalt.
- > Removing old road line markings using high pressure water jets.
- > Spraying/painting new road line markings.

How will the work affect you?

- > Work will be noisy at times. For night work, we will make every effort to complete high impact noise activities (asphalt and concrete cutting/ hammering, road profiling & hydro blasting) before midnight wherever possible.
- > **Traffic detours** and **temporary road closures** will be in place for the safety of workers and road users. Please refer to the map below outlining the local traffic changes for each section of work.
- > A bus detour via Victoria Rd & Murray St will be required for the duration of the works.
- > There will be no access to Edgeware Rd via Wells Street while night work is being done.
- > Resident access to **Darley St** between **Edgeware Rd & John St** will be via the John Street end during our work.
- > There will be a temporary loss of on-street parking while work is in progress.
- > There may be temporary closures of the footpath, however we will provide an alternative route for pedestrians.
- > Residents may experience short delays to access properties.
- > If we anticipate your driveway access may be disrupted, we will inform you in advance and discuss arrangements.
