

# Co-Location (Co-Lo) Services Application Process



## CUSTOMERS NEED TO:

- Submit all technical specifications, documentation, calculations and drawings with their application.
- Submit a Site Access Request Form providing a minimum of 48 hours notice before attending site.
- Meet TransGrid's HSE and induction requirements before accessing sites or starting work.
- Provide TransGrid with relevant Purchase Order numbers.
- Provide TransGrid with photos and as-built drawings upon completion of works (if these are not provided, TransGrid will draft as-built drawings and recoup costs from the customer).

## TECHNICAL ASSESSMENTS CONDUCTED

- Power
- Property/Environment
- Building
- Substation Design
- Structural
- High Voltage

## MAKE READY WORKS (MRW)

If the outcome of the Structural Assessment requires MRW, TransGrid will provide a:

- Detailed Design for works
- Quote for completing any such works

Once customer signs POs and Site License, TransGrid will complete all MRW.

## TRANSGRID WILL:

Send the customer a Co-Lo application approval, detailing:

- Specific installation conditions
- Approved equipment on tower and ground
- All relevant site HSE documentation
- Any additional training required
- Timeframes for site access and construction

TransGrid will also prepare and send a Site License to the customer.
